- If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child and any siblings from school immediately.

- I will not enter the school without a pre- arranged appointment – please make appointments via telephone or class email.
- I will not arrange appointments for my child during the school day.
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this pandemic.
- I need to read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home.
- I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carers and emergency contacts details.
- If my child displays unsafe behaviour; puts a member of staff or other pupils at risk, he/she will be sent home and will not return to school until they can be safe.
- I will agree to our school's reopening plan to help us keep everyone safe.

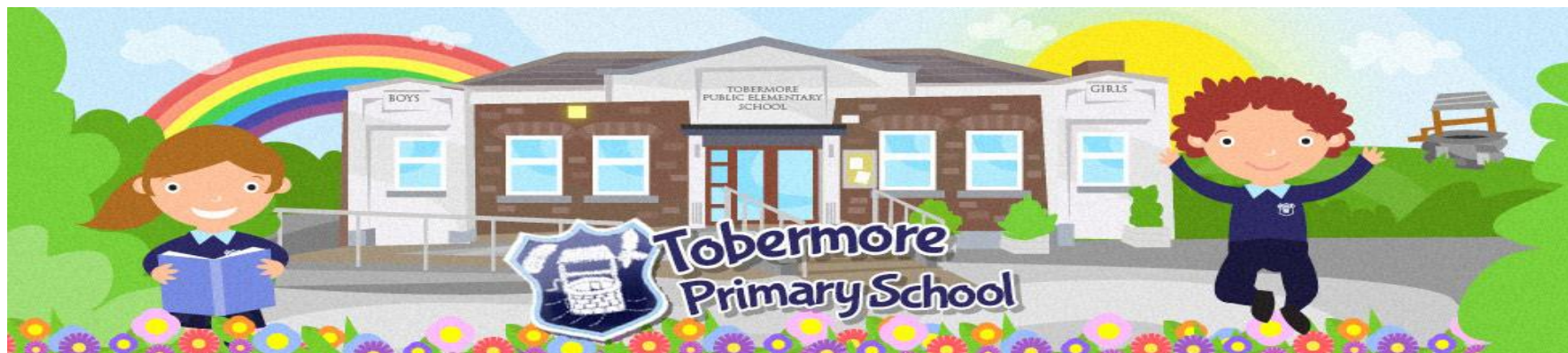
I will do my best to:
