

YOUNG MUSICIANS SUMMER ACADEMY FOR P6, P7 & Yr 8 PUPILS



FRIDAY 1st JULY 2022 to MONDAY 4th JULY 2022 COVID has led the management team to transform this event from a residential to a non-residential course. Due to the current conditions resulting from the Omicron variant and the uncertainty in the months to come, we believe it is prudent to remove the need for accommodation, as it will be difficult to guarantee the health and well-being of the pupils and staff who participate. We do however recognise the importance of allowing our young musicians the opportunities to experience music-making and social interaction with children of their own age. We will endeavour to maintain the balance between rehearsing and play in order to create a fun and educational experience. We look forward to reverting to a residential setting in the future.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

To introduce young instrumentalists to orchestral and ensemble playing, and to afford them the opportunity of meeting and socialising with others.

STAFFING

The course will be supervised by the Authority's Instrumental Tutors, all of whom have First Aid and Safeguarding Children Training. A team of Junior Staff will also assist in all aspects of the course. The decision of the Course Director will be final in all matters.

ELIGIBILITY

The course is open to all pupils at present in **P6**, **P7** or **Yr 8** who have at least one year's experience of playing orchestral instruments (including orchestral percussion, but excluding recorder and piano).

- 2. Registrations should be returned by Friday 8th April 2022. On receipt of completed registration forms, the Music Service Office will make contact to take a £30 deposit. Any applications received after this date will not be guaranteed a place on the course but will be held on a reserve list.
- 3. Successful applicants will be notified as soon as possible after this date.
- 4. The fee for the course will be £70. Details of balance payment will be issued at a later date.
- 5. Places are limited and the Course Director reserves the right to take any appropriate action to ensure a correct instrumental balance.
