Dear Parent/Guardian,

I hope you are well rested and that you all had a fun-filled summer break. It was great to see all our children return to school on Tuesday 30th August and it was especially great to see our new Year 1 pupils and pupils who have joined us from other schools becoming part of our school community. Everyone is very welcome and we are excited for the year ahead.

Please find some information below regarding arrangements for the Term 1.

School Start and End Times

Starting Times

- School will begin at 8:50 am on Tuesday 30th August for all pupils.
- Year 1 pupils will enter school by the door beside Mrs Speers' room for the first week and other arrangements for Year 1 will be made for the following week.
- Pupils from Year 2 to Year 7 will come into school via the main entrance.

Ending Times

- School will end for Year 1 pupils at 12:00pm until 16th September. Pupils will be collected at Mrs Speers' door at 12:00pm until 16th September. Year 1 pupils will then stay to 2:00pm from Monday 19th September.
- School will end for Year 2 pupils at 2:00pm.
- School will end for Year 3 pupils at 3:00pm on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. School will end for Year 3 pupils at 2:00pm on Thursday and Friday.
- School will end at 3:00pm for Year 4 to Year 7 pupils.

School Uniform

The school is very proud of its children; it is proud to see them in school uniform and insists that all children wear it every day. **All pupils are permitted to wear plain navy trousers only**. Your child will not be allowed to wear tracksuit bottoms with logos on them.

** Please also ensure that all parts of school uniform are labelled with your child's name **

Breakfast Club

Breakfast Club is open to pupils from children in Year 1 to Year 7 and will run daily from 8:20am to 8:50am. Breakfast will be charged at 80p per pupil, per day and is payable a week in advance.

Mr Hunter will be teaching our Year 2 and Year 3 classroom and Ms Henderson will be working as a classroom assistant in Year 4 and Year 5. Healthy Snack

As a school, we have a duty to ensure that there is a healthy eating policy in school and that pupils are adhering to it. Pupils should have a healthy snack with them each day for their break. Lunch boxes should also be healthy.

Dinner Money and Menu

Dinners continue to cost £2.60. If you feel you are entitled to FSM, please apply for these through the Education Authority website, even if your child does not intend to avail of this.

Please ensure that dinners are paid at the beginning of the week. The dinner menu can be found on the school website and we have sent a copy home with your child.

<u>SeeSaw</u>

Every classroom will be using SeeSaw this year to communicate with parents, display work that has been completed in the classroom and show pictures of activities. A letter will be sent home with your child this week with further information about SeeSaw.

Extra-Curricular Activities

We are hoping to start Extra Curricular activities in the next couple of weeks. We hope to offer a variety of clubs to all of our children. Please keep an eye on our school website for additional information.

<u>PE</u>

Your child's teacher will provide you with information about your child's PE day and what they will wear for PE via SeeSaw.

Homework

Homework will begin on Monday 5th September. Each teacher will send work home which may consist of reading, mental maths, written work, spellings or number facts depending on your child's age.

<u>Absences</u>
